

Call for Participation: Eurohaptics 2018 June 13-16, Pisa, Italy www.eurohaptics2018.org

Eurohaptics is a major international conference and the primary European meeting for researchers in the field of human haptics and touch enabled computer applications. This diverse field covers research on human haptic perception and haptic engineering, including end-applications such as surgical simulation, rehabilitation robotics, communication and haptic feedback for design and applied arts. **Eurohaptics 2018** is part of the activities taking place under the auspices of the Eurohaptics Society <http://eurohaptics.org>.

Eurohaptics 2018 will be held in **Pisa** on the premises of the Palazzo dei Congressi di Pisa (Pisa Congress Palace), on June 13-16, 2018. The conference will take place in the period of "Giugno Pisano" a major event in Pisa throughout the month of June, hosting a series of celebrations that fill the city with a festive atmosphere, music and explosive colors, such as the Luminara.



The conference will provide researchers from academia and industry with an opportunity to present ideas and establish contacts with other haptics researchers from around the world. Haptic hardware and software developers will be able to gain information about the latest haptics research, as well as to demonstrate their creations to a wider audience.

History and geography of Eurohaptics conferences. The Eurohaptics conference was inceptioned in 2001, Birmingham, UK and was held in Edinburgh, UK; Dublin, Ireland; and Munich, Germany before joining the IEEE Haptics Symposium every other year to form the WorldHaptics Conference (Pisa, Italy; Tsukuba, Japan; Salt Lake City, USA; Istanbul, Turkey; Daejeon, South Korea; Chicago, USA; Fürstentfeldbruck (Munich), Germany). In the alternate years, Eurohaptics was held in Paris, France; Madrid, Spain; Amsterdam, The Netherlands; Tampere, Finland, Versailles, France, and London, UK..
